ACTIVE AGGRESSOR (SHOOTER) IN PLACES OF WORSHIP

- This training will not only cover those steps but will also cover best practices to survive these types of incidents.

OTHER CRIMES IN PLACES OF WORSHIP - AN "ALL HAZARDS APPROACH"

- Information on other property crimes committed against Houses of Worship include: theft of funds, burglary, arson, and vandalism
- House of Worship members and staff are vulnerable to occurrences of personal and physical abuse
- Provide leaders with tools to responsibly screen candidates, set boundaries, maintain an atmosphere of ethical behavior, and sustain a safe overall environment
- Prevent accidents, injury, and neglect, safeguarding against loss from crime and theft of funds, protecting members and staff from abuse, liability, false claims, and lawsuits.
